2009 BRIDGEWATER STATE COLLEGE BEARS BASKETBALL CAMP

Welcome to Bridgewater State and the 16th annual “Bears Basketball Camp”. This year’s camp will once again feature the Bridgewater State men’s basketball coaching staff headed by **Coach Joe Farroba**.

This camp is geared toward those boys and girls who desire knowledge of the fundamentals of the game of basketball. The five-day camp consists of six (6) hours of instruction each day by the Bears coaching staff and special guest speakers.

There will be a lunch break each day where **lunch** will be served to all campers at the college cafeteria. There will also be a **certified athletic trainer** on duty during the camp in case of injury.

Get a jump on your teammates before the upcoming basketball season. Sharpen your skills to be the best you can be. Attend the Bridgewater Bears Basketball Camp. You will be glad you did!!!

Participants will be grouped by **age** and/or **skill** level. Participants must wear **sneakers with non-marking soles**. Campers may wish to bring other personal equipment such as water bottles, a fresh shirt, etc.

Full Day Program for the Summer of 2009

CUB CLINIC

Cub Clinic is for children ages 5, 6, & 7 and is being held over two full-days, Tue. July 28 and Thurs. July 30, from 8:45 am to 2:45 pm. The camp will take place on it’s own court in the Tinsley Center.

The clinic is designed for younger basketball players who are not ready for a full week of camp but are ready for fun and basketball. Basic skills will be introduced and emphasized along with contests and games.

This is a great opportunity to for the kids to start learning about basketball and getting out of the hot July sun and into the air conditioned Tinsley Center.

Drop-off and Pick-up time is the same as our regular camp so parents with older children in camp have the convenience of a single pick-up time. Lunch is included.

FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

The “Bridgewater Bears Basketball Camp” will utilize Bridgewater State’s Adrian Tinsley Center for the day-long sessions. The ATC contains a 30,000 square foot gymnasium area with 14 shooting baskets and three full game courts for game and drill sessions.

The entire facility is air-conditioned during camp hours.

Parents may stay and observe the sessions while they are in progress.

Joe Farroba – Camp Director

Coach Farroba has been the head coach for men’s basketball at Bridgewater State College since 1992. He has led the Bears to three conference championships and three NCAA Division III tournament appearances. He has also been named conference “Coach of the Year” twice.

Jim O’Connell – Program Director

Jim is entering his 9th season as an assistant for the Bears. A 1994 graduate of Providence College, Jim has also coached at Colby Community College in Kansas (1995) and Dean College (1995-2001), along with extensive experience working for basketball camps throughout the northeast region. Jim will direct the daily program of activities during camp.

Mike Donovan —Associate Basketball Coach

Entering his 13th season as Coach Farroba’s top assistant; Mike is a former player at Assumption College (1972-74) and an assistant coach at Mass. Maritime Academy (1978-82). He was the head coach for boy’s basketball at Falmouth High School (1982-87). He has also worked as an official at both the high school and collegiate level and is a frequent guest lecturer at other area camps.
