What Constitutes a Critique?

A critique consists of :

- The original *written* critique sent to another team.
- *All* Blackboard postings whereby the critiquing team attempted to clarify, amplify or otherwise explain the initial written critique to the team being criticized.

A **full** critique consists of *both* of the above.

Kindly rate the critique on **both** of the above elements. A critique is to receive only one rating, not two ratings. *One overall rating. One rating overall!*

The Rating Scale

5= *A truly superior critique.*

- Everything was well done. Impressive. Classy.
- Each of the 3 Spool questions, as modified for ED 235, was addressed and fully examined on Blackboard.
- Original *written* critique consisted of at least 100 words.

4= *A good critique.*

- The 3 core questions were treated in decent manner on BB.
- Yet the critique lacked some of the brilliance and/or depth of a "true 5-er".
- Still commendable. Adequate and useful.
- Original *written* critique consisted of at least 100 words.

3= *An average, "run of the mill" critique.*

- Although the 3 core questions were brought up and considered, coverage tended to tilt toward the superficial side.
- Valid points were touched upon, but mostly inadequately developed or explained.
- A critique of this caliber, while representing *minimum* level of acceptable performance, is nothing to "write home about".
- Original *written* critique consisted of at least 100 words.

2= *Inadequate.*

A critique rated this low will earn the instructor's immediate attention. He will question the team as to why this happened. *Any written* critique less than 100 words earns a "2" instantly.

1= *You call this a "critique"? Frankly, we are uncertain as to exactly what it is!*
